PLACE ROLL CARTS AT THE CURB 4 FEET APART FROM OTHER ITEMS BY 6 AM ON COLLECTION DAY MIXED RECYCLING IS COLLECTED EVERY OTHER WEEK -- REFER TO COLOR CODED CALENDAR

Mixed Recycling

These Items Go In The MIXED RECYCLING ROLL CART:

Paper & Non-Waxed Cardboard

Iunk Mail

Gift Wrap (No foil, Ribbons & Bows)

Magazines

Newspaper

Paperboard (Cereal-Type Boxes)

Phone Books & Paperback Books

Office Paper

Cardboard

Plastics *Empty, Clean, & Dry!* Plastic Bottles Plastic Jugs

(Discard caps and pumps)

Metal Empty, Clean, & Dry! Tin & Aluminum Cans (Paper Labels are okay)









- All mixed recyclables must fit inside the roll cart
- Please do not place recyclables in plastic bags
- No food contaminated items
- No egg. juice, or milk cartons
- No frozen food boxes
- Unacceptable or incorrectly prepared materials will be charged a contamination fee

Small Recycling Bin

These Items Go In The

SMALL RECYCLING BIN:

Household Batteries

Alkaline, rechargeable, and small button cells. Sizes AAAA through D, 6 Volt - 9 Volt. Must be sealed in a zip-sealed bag.



Usable Latex Paint and Oil Based Paint Place up to 2, one-gallon labeled cans.

Please; NO rusty cans!

Used Motor Oil

In a sealed, leak-proof, plastic screw-top container no larger than one gallon.



Place into screw-top see-thru plastic jug. Keep separate from motor oil.



Please keep bottle and jars empty, clean, and dry! (No broken glass) No other types of glass please.



Vegetable Cooking Oil

Place up to 2 gallons of cooled oil into original or clean see-thru plastic screwtop container.



IMPORTANT

The items above must be placed inside the small recycling bin
